

Cochrane & Area Humane Society Scholarship

General Information

The Cochrane and Area Humane Society Scholarship will be awarded to qualified graduates from Cochrane and area high schools. Up to three scholarships will be awarded annually.

Each \$1000 scholarship will go towards the student's tuition at a secondary institution. Successful applicants should have recently made a significant volunteer contribution at the Cochrane & Area Humane Society (CAHS) and have an interest in pursuing a career related to animal care, health or medicine.

Deadlines

All application materials must be completed and submitted before April 30th, 2010.

Required Documents

- Completed application form
- Application form read and signed by a teacher or other professional and senior CAHS staff
- Copy of acceptance letter from a post secondary institution

Eligibility

- Student must have attended a Cochrane and area high school for the last three years and be enrolled to graduate.
- Student must be attending a post-secondary institute and show dedication to pursuing a career in a field related to animal care, health or medicine.
- Preference will be given to students who have completed meaningful volunteer hours at the Cochrane and Area Humane Society
- Preference will be given to well-rounded students who have demonstrated participation in extracurricular activities, school sports, or part time employment.

Amount

- \$1000 to be applied to tuition at a post-secondary institution
